

Does My Project Require Human Ethics Approval?

The following requires ethics review and approval by a Research Ethics Board (REB) in accordance with the [Tri-Council Policy Statement](#) **before** the research is started:

- living human participants;
- human biological materials, as well as human embryos, fetuses, fetal tissue, reproductive materials and stem cells. This applies to materials derived from living and deceased individual;
- secondary use of data, health information, or biological materials.”
